CONDITIONS OF AFFILIATION

- Fach and every one of the recommendations of the University Inspection commission should be implemented with out delay; (copy enclosed)
- 2 The annual intake of students strength sanctioned for 1st year of B.E. Degree courses should not be exceeded as recommended by the A.I.C.T.E. and the University Inspection
- 3 The College should have permanent building and accommodation should be made available for proposed courses:
- 4 Conditions stipulated by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi in its letter F No.730/52/304(E)/ET/97 dated 18-11-1997.
- 5 The Provisional Affiliation in the above courses are granted without prejudice to the final decision of the Supreme Court of India pending in Civil Appeals against Adhiyaman College of Engineering Hosur;
- The maximum number of students that may be admitted to the courses should not exceed the strength recommended by the commission;
- 7. Library and Laboratory should be strengthened as suggested by the communications;
- 8 The Staff as recommended by the Commission should be appointed subject to the stipulations of the AICTE/University;
- 9. The teachers appointed should not exceed the age of superannuation which may be prescribed by the Government/University from time to time:
- 10. The courses should be conducted in accordance with the regulations and syllabi approved by the University from time to time;
- 11 Arrangements should be made for the conduct of the proper timely and orderly conduct of the University Examinations;
- 12. The Staff Pattern with prescribed qualifications by the University as well as AICTE should be followed;
- 13 The candidate shall eath the required attendance prior to admission to the respective
- 14 Approval should be obtained from the University before appointing the teaching staff in the college;
 - 15 A Librarian, a Medical Officer and a Physical Director with the requisite qualifications prescribed by the University should be appointed, immediately;
 - 16 The college should not obtain donations from the students seeking admission to any course of study in the college;
 - 17 Scales of Pay and allowances prescribed from time to time by the Government/AICTE or by the University whichever is higher should be adopted by the Management of the college for all categories of staff (Teaching and Non-teaching) and furnish the details of their salaries to the University.
 - 18 Suitable leave rules generally in conformity with the State Government rules should be framed.
 - 19. The management of the College should enter into an agreement with the teachers appointed as required in the conditions of service of teachers prescribed by the University.
 - 20 Land and Endowment conditions as per Covt. Order No.(Ms) No.97 Higher Education Department dated 19-03-1998 most be fulfilled:

- Norms & Guidelines for opening of Engineering Colleges (Volume 1 & Volume II) should be complied with;
- 23. The College should collect Tuition and other fees from the students a the rates prescribed by the Government/AICTE;
- 24. All further conditions of affiliation as laid down in Chapter XXVI of the Madras University Calendar, Volume 1, 1985 as amended should be complied with;
- 25. Such other conditions as may be prescribed by the University from time to time should also be complied with;
- 26. If the conditions of provisional affiliation granted are not complied with, it will be automatically be enforced.

In communicating the above, I am, by direction, to request the Management to kindly let me have a detailed report regarding the fulfillment of all the above conditions of affiliation for the academic year 1998-99.

It may also kindly be noted that no admission should be made to all the above courses for the academic year 1999-2000 until specific permission is granted by the University.
